SAFE STEMI for Seniors: Study of Access Site for Enhancing PCI in STEMI for Seniors

SAFE STEMI for Seniors is a randomized, open-label study to simultaneously address four potential advances in ST-elevation myocardial infarction (STEMI) care for patients at least 65 years old.

1. Opening the arteries with a Medtronic stent
2. Radial access success with a Medtronic stent
3. Checking the percent of blockage in the diseased artery/arteries using Volcano guide wires.
4. Reduced bleeding and vascular complications with radial arterial access for primary PCI in STEMI.

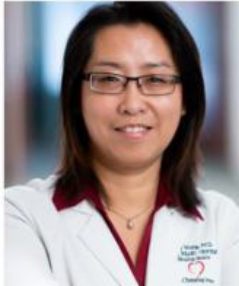
